STEM -RASE – Rivers Academy for STEM Excellence

The Rivers Academy of STEM Excellence (RASE) is a collaborative project between local public high schools, primary schools and industry, and is designed to provide our students with access to innovative and real-world learning experiences.

We are fortunate to be one of six primary schools involved in the pilot program. Our teachers have engaged in a variety of professional learning over the past two terms to support the teaching of STEM.

In addition to providing strong foundational knowledge in STEM, students will develop the key skills of problem solving, communication, collaboration, creativity and critical thinking through an inquiry learning model based on the design thinking process.



We look forward to showcasing our work through the school newsletter and Facebook. The RASE Facebook page currently features our ProBL unit based on creating a Cardboard Arcade. Next week Stage 2 and 3 students will be working with the Head Teacher of Science from the The Rivers Secondary College learning about electronic circuits. Students will be encouraged to add circuits to their arcade games.

Kindergarten and Preschool Promotion

Our Early Stage 1 team have been busy preparing videos to support families with students starting preschool and kindergarten. The videos have been shared with families via an email link and also feature on our school Facebook page.

Term 4

Camps, Kindergarten Orientation programs and some end of year celebrations remain on hold. We expect to hear from the NSW Premier about the Term 4 Guidelines during the September/October school holidays.
