SCHOOL SWIMMING CARNIVAL – 9th February 2022

Due to the current COVID guidelines, the school swimming carnival will be a **COMPETITORS ONLY event** this year. This means that students who return their permission note stating they will not be competing, will be expected to attend school as normal.

Students will not be permitted to attend if displaying any symptoms of illness, and/or if directed to isolate under public health orders. We encourage all parents and carers to administer a Rapid Antigen Test on the morning of the carnival to check their child is COVID negative.

FOR: Stage 2 & 3 (Years 3 - 6) and Year 2 students, (*turning 8 this year*), **who can swim 50 metres and wish to compete in an event may attend.**

Students will need to nominate the events they wish to swim in, for organisation of races and Covid Safe marshalling. **Students must be able to confidently swim 50m in the stroke of the event they are nominating for.** Children will be seated in their age group, not in House groups as part of our Covid Safe plan.

Supervision will be provided at school for students who are not participating.

WHERE: LISMORE MEMORIAL BATHS

TRAVEL/TIME: Bus departs from school at **9.30 am** and will return by **2.30 pm**.

COST: \$6.00 (Bus, pool entry & hire fee) **CASH ONLY – PLEASE NO POP PAYMENTS**

SPORT HOUSES: Sport houses are determined by the surname of the student.

Students are encouraged to dress in House colours. NO crepe paper or coloured hairspray.

LUNCH: Please bring lunch, recess and bottle of water/drink from home or lunch may be purchased from pool kiosk.

SPECTATORS: Due to DOE COVID-19 restriction, parents and caregivers are unfortunately NOT permitted to attend.

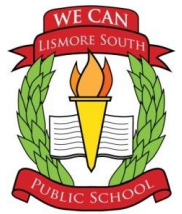
Participants must return the permission note with payment, and nomination form to the school office by **MONDAY, 7th FEBRUARY**.

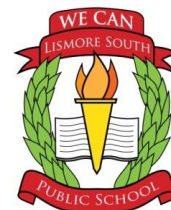
